By 2020

- We see three services each weekend reaching 1500 people, broadcast live.
- We will have leadership teams, groups and a mission outpost in each city in South Orange County.
- We will publish worship albums, books, curriculum, videos and trainings by 2020.
- We will host four Unleashed conferences per year and two conferences that teach our values.
- We will have a functioning Intern program and ministry school.
- We will plant a bi-lingual church that reaches the local Latino community San Juan Capistrano.
